

Property Tax and Rent Rebate Program

Who is eligible?

Pennsylvanians aged 65 and older; widows and widowers aged 50 and older; and people with disabilities aged 18 and older.

*Applicants can exclude half of Social Security or Railroad Retirement Tier I income and take a deduction for Civil Service Retirement System income.
